Therefore, we would like to encourage all ASAF members to **submit their feedback** by filling in the survey you find in the news feed of the [ASAF online community](#).

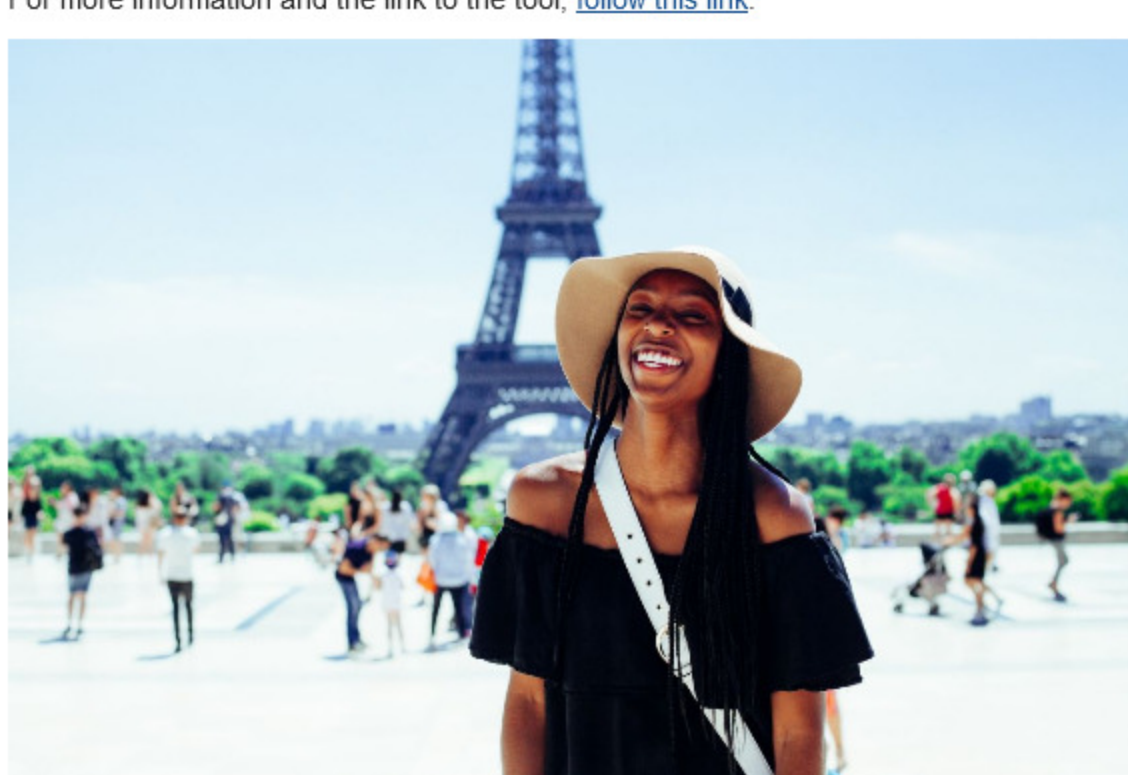
We would like to emphasize that participation is completely anonymous and that both **positive comments and criticism** can be freely expressed. The survey takes about 4 minutes.
